Please note the information that is required with your Numerative and Named Entries such as: travel details, deposits and fees, team lists, photo IDs, and general crew details.

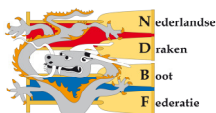

Official Invitation

On behalf of the Board and Council of the European Dragon Boat Federation (EDBF) you are cordially invited to send your Dragon Boat National Team to participate in the EUROPEAN NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIPS DRAGONBOAT RACING 2010 to be held in Amsterdam, The Netherlands, on 13-14-15 August 2010.

The EUROPEAN NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010 dragonboat racing (ENC2010), which is open to all Dragon Boat National Teams in Europe who comply with the EDBF Competition Regulations for European dragonboat racing championships (EDBRC) and will be organized on behalf of the EDBF, by the Nederlandse Drakenboot Federatie (NDBF) and its appointed Organizing Committee, to whom all entries for the Championships should be submitted. De Bosbaan regatta course has been approved by the EDBF as the location for the ENC2010. The course is a placid body of water with a depth of 2.5 meters and the racing area is a straight 2000 meter course. It is wide enough to accommodate six racing lanes of at least 13.5 meters each.

The EUROPEAN NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010 dragonboat racing will be for Premier, Senior, Junior & Grand Dragons crews, over the race distances of 200, 500 and 2000 meters competition.

The EDBF Board encourages your association to enter your national teams in the EUROPEAN NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010 and looks forward meeting with representatives from your crews during the Championship.
