All European Dragon Boat Federation Members

The European Dragon Boat Federation Council in conjunction with the Kiev (Kyiv) 2021 Organizing Committee, the Ukrainian Dragon Boat Federation and the City of Kyiv, warmly invite all EDBF Members' Club Crews and National Dragon Boat Teams to participate in the 18th EDBF European Club Crew Championships (ECCC) 2021 and the 14th European Nations Championships (ENC) which due to the Covid-19 pandemic was postponed from 2020.

The ENC will be held from Tuesday 17th- Thursday 19th August 2021 and the ECCC will be held from Friday 20th- Sunday 22nd August 2021, at the Obolon Water Stadium in Kiev (Kyiv), the Ukraine. Friday 20th August may also be a racing day for the ENC, dependant on the Confirmed Entries received – see Information Bulletin No.1 attached.

Due to the continuing prevalence of Covid-19 in Europe and the uncertainty of when an effective vaccine will be given to all age groups in Europe, the EDBF Council emphasizes that the arrangements for the joint Kiev Championships' are provisional , at this stage and subject to the on-going restrictions for travel, social distancing, self-isolating, taking part in outdoor activities and sports events that government agencies in Europe have introduced in 2020, which may or may not change during the early months of 2021.

To assist the EDBF and the Organizing Committee (Org Com) in their logistical and competition forward planning, all EDBF Members are requested to complete the **"Intention to Compete"** (ITC) proforma at the end of Information Bulletin No.1 attached and return it as shown by **Friday 22nd January 2021**.

Completing the proforma and returning it as requested, will help the EDBF Council, at its next meeting on 26th January 2021, to determine the final format for the Championships' Week and each championship's competition program, taking into account the intentions of the EDBF Members and their Clubs, as notified to the Council by 20th January and the possible situations that might arise in regard to Covid-19.

Club Crews from European Countries **not** in EDBF membership may apply to the EDBF Executive Committee for permission to participate and should therefore complete the ITC proforma.

Subject to the information submitted on the ITC proforma, it is the intention to offer races for Open, Women's and Mixed Crews in during the Championships' week in the Racing and Competition Classes shown in Information Bulletin No.1 attached.

The EDBF Council, the Kiev Organizing Committee and the Ukraine Dragon Boat Federation look forward to welcoming EDBF Member crews and teams to Kiev 2021, for a Covid-19 free event.

INFORMATION BULLETIN No. 1 **14th EUROPEAN NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIP &** **18th EUROPEAN CLUB CREWS CHAMPIONSHIPS** *Obolon Water Stadium, Kiev (Kyiv), Ukraine* **17th – 22nd AUGUST 2021**

The postponed 14th European Nations Championships (ENC) 2020, will be held from **Tuesday 17th- Thursday 19th August 2021** and the 18th EDBF European Club Crew Championships (ECCC) 2021 will be held from the 17th - 22th August 2021. For the ENC training days will be on Sunday 15th and Monday 16th August 2021.

We recommend that National Teams competing crews in the ENC arrive in Kiev (Kyiv) by Saturday 14th August 2021 and Club Crews for the ECCC by Thursday, 18th August 2021.

LOCATION

The 14th EDBF ENC and the 18th EDBF ECCC will be held at the Obolon Water Stadium in Kiev (Kyiv), the venue of previous international dragon boat competitions and the Ukrainian Dragon Boat Championships. It is situated on the River Dnieper, the biggest in Ukraine, which flows through the center of the country. The venue is located approximately 41Km from Boryspil International Airport (KBP) and 22Km from Kyiv Airport Zhuliany (IEV). Accommodation will be available within 20km - 30 minutes from the race site.

REGATTA COURSE

The regatta course and technical facilities will be according to EDBF standards for European Nations Championships.

- Address:** Obolonska Nabereszhna Street, 27, Kyiv, Ukraine
Width: 280m – 350m wide
Depth: 9m – 17m over full distance and full width of race course.
Racing Lanes: 6 lanes of 13.5m width
Water Temperature: 21 – 22 degrees Celsius in August (August is the warmest month).

An IMAS starting system will be used with a fixed start tower at each starting position. Photo finish and electronic results processing will be provided.

One small tent will be provided for each small ENC Team and ECCC Crew and a larger one for bigger ENC Teams or ECCC Club Teams of more than one crew. Detailed information regarding crew tents, the grandstand and parking facilities for both guests and competitors will follow in later Bulletins.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

ENC: one (1) crew per Nation or Territory shall be allowed to compete in each Competition Class listed in the Championships Programme

ECCC: a total of seven (7) combined small and standard crews in the same competition class may compete from one EDBF member. The seven (7) crews will include a maximum of five (5) Standard and two (2) Small boats. Allocation of entries will be nominated by the sanctioning IDBF Member concerned. ECCC Crews from countries where there is not an EDBF Member may compete subject to the agreement of the EDBF Executive Committee.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The Championship will be conducted according to the EDBF Competition Regulations and IDBF Rules of Racing – Edition 8 (released 1st January 2020). The racing will be conducted by IDBF International Race Officials and assisted by National Officials and volunteers under the direction of an EDBF Chief Official and with a Jury nominated by the EDBF Executive Committee.

Racing and Competition Classes. Subject to the information received on the ITC proformas from EDBF Members, it is the intention to offer championships' in the following Racing and Competition Classes;

Racing Classes: Premier, Senior A, B, C, Under 24, Junior. ECCC only - BCS and Para Dragons.

Competition Classes: ENC 200m, 500m and 2000m.

ECCC 200m, 500m and 2000m.

All racing distances will be held in both Standard and Small boats, if there are sufficient Provisional Entries received by the closing date for Provisional Entries – see below.

The Championships will use the EDBF Race Plans to determine the racing program.

PADDLERS MAY COMPETE IN BOTH THE ENC AND THE ECCC if selected to do so.

ENTRIES

When called for all Provisional, Confirmed and Named entries must be made on the IDBF registration system at https://idbfchamps.org/login_edbf.php. The system will open from **Monday, 8th March 2021**.

INTENDED ENTRIES

All Nations are required to submit their INTENDED entries without payment of the first deposit, due the covid-19 crisis, no later than Friday 22nd January 2021 as the EDBF Council that meets on the 26th January to review all the logistical, administrative and technical matters concerning the joint championships, in light of the Covid-19 situation in Europe, at that time.

PROVISIONAL ENTRIES

All Nations and Clubs are required to submit their Provisional Entries no later than **Friday 2nd April 2021** (Easter Friday). Once the deadline for Provisional Entries has closed, the EDBF will then review the number of entries in each competition class and category. Should there be insufficient entries, then some classes may be cancelled (one or two entries) or combined (three to five entries).

CONFIRMED FINAL ENTRIES

All Nations and Clubs are required to submit their Confirmed Entries no later than **Friday 2nd July 2021, six weeks before the joint championships start.**

NAMED ENTRIES

All Nations and Clubs are required to submit their Named Entries (including team member details & photographs) by **Friday 16th July 2021**, one month before the joint championships start.

VISAS. Citizens of an EU Member State and British Citizen passport holders can enter Ukraine without a visa for visits of up to 90 days. Anyone else requiring visas to enter Ukraine should apply directly to the organizing committee by email

BOATS AND EQUIPMENT

IDBF licensed Peisheng-BuK Dragon Boats will be provided by the Championship organizers. Competing crews will be expected to bring their own paddles that conform to the IDBF Paddle Specification 202a.

FEES

ADMINISTRATION FEE - There will be an Administration Fee of €60.00/person (adult) for anyone traveling with the team, including competitors, coaches and managers + €10.00/person for Athletes competing both in the ENC and in the ECCC. There will be an Administration Fee of €30.00/person for all juniors whose 18th birthday falls in the year of competition or younger. No surcharge for Juniors competing both in the ENC and in the ECCC. **Due to the changing situation concerning Covid-19, Administration Fees will not be required before the closing date for Confirmed Entries (2nd July 2021).**

EDBF REGISTRATION FEE – There will be an EDBF Registration Fee of €20.00/person (adult) for anyone traveling with the team, including competitors, coaches and managers. There will be an EDBF Registration Fee of €5.00/person for all juniors whose 18th birthday falls in the year of competition or younger. Team Manager's will register their team members on the EDBF registration system and generate their own invoices. **Due to the changing situation concerning Covid-19, Registration Fees will not be required before the closing date for Named Entries (16th July 2021)**

SUPPORTERS FEE - It has been agreed that Supporters will pay a reduced Administration Fee of €18.00/person + an EDBF Registration Fee of €7.00/person. Supporters who are under the age of 12 are free of charge, but must be accompanied by an adult with an ID tag at all times. The entry fee will entitle people to receive an accreditation card, which makes it possible to enter the competition areas. The competition site (besides the boarding zone) will not be opened to the public. **Due to the changing situation concerning Covid-19, Supporters Fees will not be required before the date of arrival in Kiev.**

Further details concerning any deposits to be paid and the process for the payment of administration, registration and supporters fees will be confirmed in further Bulletins, dependent on any restrictions placed on attending the joint championships by developments in the Covid-19 pandemic.

DIVISIONS, RACING CLASSES, COMPETITION CLASSES AND RACE DISTANCES. If a team wishes to enter a standard and small boat competition class, the competitors in the standard boat must be completely different to those in the small boat. The 26 competitors (including reserves, drummer and steerer) in the standard boat must be completely different to the 14 competitors (including reserves, drummer and steerer) in the small boat. Competitors from the open and women classes may combine to form Mixed Crews.

MIXED BOAT REQUIREMENTS

Standard Boat Crews – The crew must consist of a minimum of 8 and a maximum of 10 paddlers of either gender. Drummers and helms can be either gender.

10 male paddlers / 10 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
10 male paddlers / 9 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
9 male paddlers / 10 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
10 male paddlers / 8 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
8 male paddlers / 10 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
9 male paddlers / 9 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender

Small Boat Crews - The crew must consist of a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 5 paddlers of either gender. Drummers and helms can be either gender. The following table shows the composition of crews.

Small Boat

5 male paddlers / 5 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
5 male paddlers / 4 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
4 male paddlers / 5 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender
4 male paddlers / 4 female paddlers	+ drummer and helm of either gender

A new regulation will be introduced for 2020 which will be Edition 8 of the IDBF Competition Regulations.

CR 2.2.1 mixed crews

When there are sufficient numbers of men and women competitors entered in either or both small or standard boat open and women classes then the mixed entry must be made in the standard boat.

AGE REGULATIONS

Junior A – 13th to 18th birthday falls in the year of competition (minimum age of 12).

Junior B - 13th to 16th birthday falls in the year of competition (minimum age of 12).

24 and under – 13th to 24th birthday falls in the year of competition (minimum age of 12).

Senior A – 40th or later birthday falls in the year of competition.

Senior B – 50th or later birthday falls in the year of competition.

Senior C – 60th or later birthday falls in the year of competition.

Note: The Drummer in a Senior Crew and the Helm (Sweep) in a Junior Crew do not need to conform to the relevant age limits as detailed above.

PERSONAL SAFETY. All crew members must be water confident and ideally be able to swim at least 50m. It is the Crew Manager's responsibility to ensure that this limitation is complied with, and to ensure that known weak swimmers wear personal flotation aids. Crews compete entirely at their own risk and must be 'Fit to Race', as defines in the IDBF Competition Regulations.

EUROPEAN NATIONS CHAMPIONSHIPS (ENC) only.

Representation and Nationality (IDBF Competition Regulation 4)

CR 4.1 Representation. To represent a country in an EDBF Championship for Representative Crews, a Dragon Boat Competitor must normally be a citizen of or born in the country represented and be able to prove this by showing an official document, such as a Passport, Identity Card, Birth Certificate, or the like.

Dual Nationality Competitors with dual nationality (citizenship) may represent the Country or Territory of their Birth or their dual citizen Country or Territory, whichever of these they are residing in, providing that they have been resident in that Country or Territory for a current period of at least 3 years. Competitors who do not meet these requirements must comply with Regulation 4.2 or 4.2a.

CR4.2 Country or Territory Residence. Dragon Boat competitors who have left their country of birth and are a permanent, not a temporary resident in another country may represent that country if they have lived there for a current period of three (3) years or more and have not represented their country of birth, during the previous two (2) years.

Temporary Residency. A Temporary Resident, for the purposes of this Regulation, is a person who resides in a Country by virtue of holding a visa, for example a visitor's visa, student visa, work visa or the like. The EDBF considers such visas to indicate a 'temporary' residency in the Country concerned, not a permanent residency.

a. Exceptionally, competitors who have a permanent residential qualification of less than 3 years and who have not represented an EDBF Member previously, may with the permission of both their birth and residential EDBF Member, apply to the EDBF Executive Board for permission to compete for their country of residence. When permission is given, the competitor concerned will not be allowed to compete for any other Country for a minimum period of 2 years following the year in which the permission was given.

b. (4.2) Competitors who, by marriage have acquired the nationality of another country may compete for that country without delay.

PARADRAGONS and BCS. The EDBF is pleased to announce that the 18th EDBF ECCC will include Paradrakon and BCS races. Paradrakon racing is aimed at broadening the reach of our sport by encouraging those with physical, psychological, neurological, sensory or intellectual impairments to participate. The Paradrakon category offered is 'PD2' where half the paddlers have a recognised impairment. Please refer to the IDBF Framework Rules for a definition of 'PD2'.

Note for PARADRAGON that there is no age or gender requirement for this category, but the set of rules does set out how age and gender will be taken into account. Any questions regarding the set of rules or the nature of competition should be sent by email to chair-para@idbf.org. The categories, race distances, and boat types that will finally be offered will depend on the initial level of interest expressed by nations.

DOUBLE ROSTERING. Double Rostering concerns competitors in more than one competition class.

A competitor, including drummer and helms, should only enter one (1) Racing Class. No allowance will be made in the program or races delayed to allow a competitor to participate in more than one (1) Racing Class. Example. A competitor should not enter both the 500m Open and 500m Senior A competitions, unless they are on different racing days but could enter the 500m Open and the 200m Senior A competitions, on the same day.

Note, if a competitor enters more than one Racing Class, no changes will be made to the racing program time-table to accommodate double rostering. For BCS and PD2 Classes the double rostering rule will be better specified in next bulletins.

ACCOMMODATION. It is recommended that all accommodation bookings including hotels, hostels and others are to be arranged through the Organizing Committee.

Further details of the classes of accommodation available and costs will be published in Info Bul No.2, but as a guide, daily hotel prices, including breakfast, will range from Euro 50.00 (3 star single) to Euro 230.00 (5 star double) per room, with Economy Hostel accommodation at Euro 15.00 per person. Dinner prices will range from Euro 10 -15, per person. Transport from the accommodation to the regatta venue will be included in the hotel price.

RACE LUNCHES AND CATERING AT VENUE. Participants will be able to book a lunch menu (meal) with the Organizing Committee at a cost of €15.00 per person. Further details and the booking form will be included in a later Bulletin with the Confirmed Entry form. There will also be a food court zone at the race venue with various bars, restaurants and food and drink stands.

ARRIVAL / DEPARTURE TRANSFER SERVICE The Organizing Committee will arrange meet and greet pick-ups from and to both Boryspil International Airport (KBP) and from Kyiv Airport Zhuliany (IEV). Note, there will be one trip on arrival and one trip on departure per crew only. Transport costs will not exceed those shown below.

Transport from the accommodation to the race venue will be included in the hotel price. Further information will be provided in Bulletin no. 2.

OPENING CEREMONIES.

Covid-19 restrictions permitting, the ENC Opening Ceremony will take place on Monday, 16th August 2021. The ECCC Opening Ceremony will be held on Thursday 18th August 2021. Final confirmation of the Opening Ceremonies and the details of times and places will be made in early August.

CLOSING CEREMONIES.

Covid-19 restrictions permitting, the ENC Closing Ceremony will take place on Thursday 18th August 2021. The ECCC Closing Ceremony will be held on Sunday 22nd August 2021. Final confirmation of the Closing Ceremonies and the details of times and places will be made in early August.

CELEBRATION PARTY – NATIONS DINNER.

Covid-19 restrictions permitting, **it is planned to hold** only one celebration party for all ENC and ECCC competitors, coaches, managers and registered supporters on Sunday, 22nd August 2021. Final confirmation of the Celebration Party and the details of times and places will be made in early August. The anticipated ticket cost will be Euro 20.00 per person. However, if there is sufficient demand from the ENC paddlers, the Org Com will look at the feasibility of holding a separate ENC Nations Dinner on Thursday 18th August 2021, possibly after the ENC Closing Ceremony and the ECCC Opening Ceremony.

PAYMENTS for ACCOMMODATION, TRANSPORTATION, MEALS, CELEBRATION PARTY, REGATTA FEES

The details of when and how payments for Accommodation, Transport, the Celebration Party and all Regatta Fees (Admin, Registration and Supporters) will be notified in further Information Bulletins but the EDBF will do its best to ensure that no fees are paid in full until after the closing date for Named Entries (16th July 2021) and that any deposits that are required are kept as low as possible and ideally lodged with the EDBF Treasurer for safekeeping.

Teams and Crews are advised not to pay any deposits for their accommodation before the date for Confirmed Entries (2nd July 2021) and then only if they receive a guarantee in writing from the accommodation venue concerned that any deposit will be returned to them in the event that Covid-19 restrictions prevent them from attending the event.
